Applications to Dentistry, Medicine, Veterinary Science/Medicine, Oxford University and University of Cambridge

15 October 2008

Deadline for applications for all courses at Oxford University and University of Cambridge.

Deadline for applications to Dentistry, Medicine, Veterinary Medicine and Veterinary Science. Only four choices for these subjects.

1 September 2008 – 15 January 2009
Application completed with up to five choices.

School or college adds reference, sends application to UCAS.

UCAS sends acknowledgement to applicant, who checks it carefully.

UCAS sends copies of application to all universities and colleges chosen.

Each university or college makes decision on application.

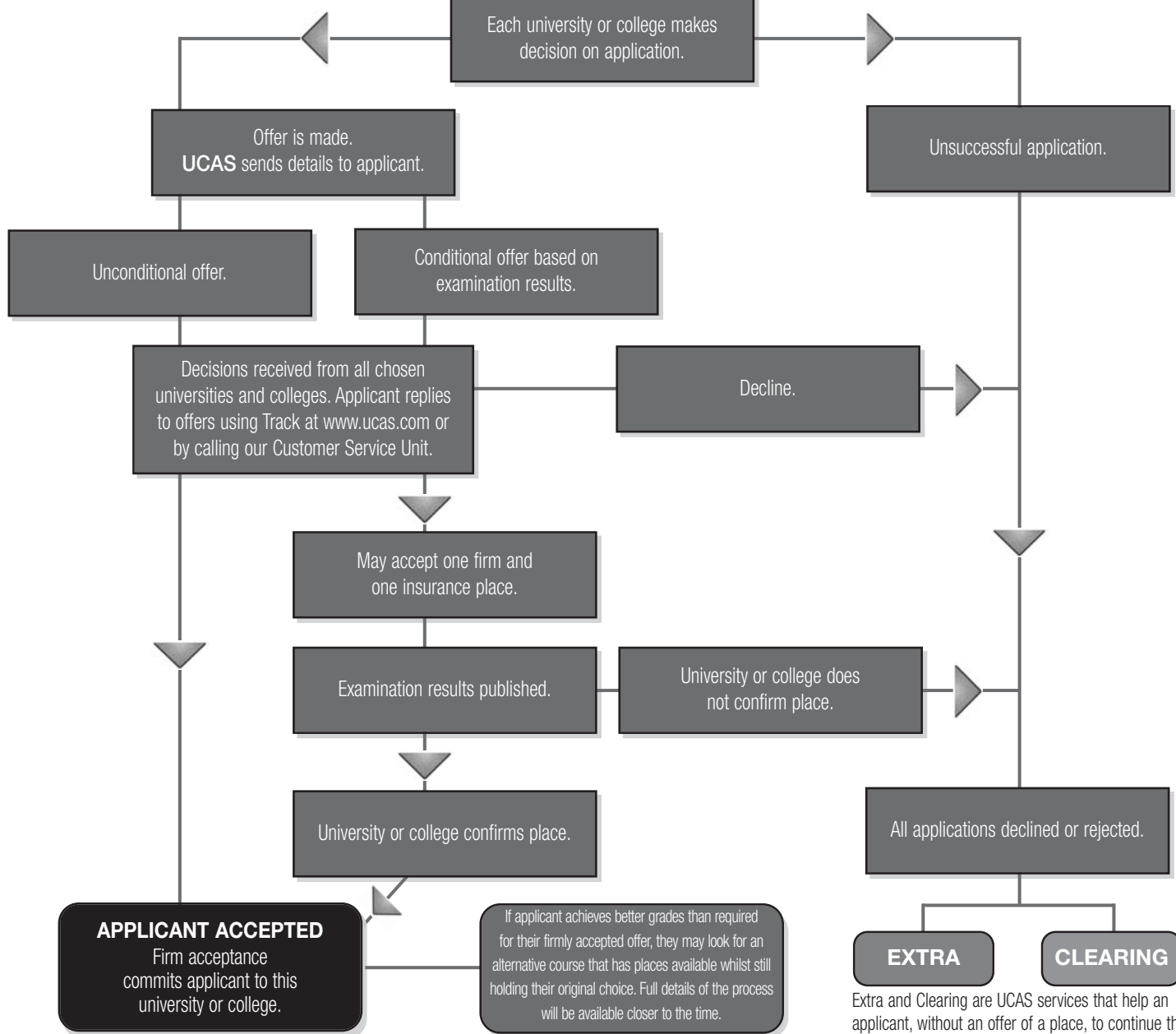
Late Applications

16 January to 30 June 2009

Applications received between these dates are **Late Applications**. Universities and colleges will consider them if they want to make more offers.

30 June 2009

Applications received after 30 June are entered in Clearing.
